

**COTTRELLVILLE TOWNSHIP
ST. CLAIR COUNTY, STATE OF MICHIGAN**

RESOLUTION R-2016-04

WHEREAS, the Township of Cottrellville in the County of St. Clair, State of Michigan, desires to collect all outstanding delinquent water and/or sewer bills from municipal water provided by local municipalities who supply our township lines with municipal water, and the residents who do not pay their invoices and are "Past Due" by October 31st, of the year in question, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Cottrellville Township is willing to work out a "Payment Plan" through the Township Clerk's office, in which payments will be accepted up until that October 31st date, at which time, all outstanding balances shall be placed as a lien for charges for services furnished by the Cottrellville Township Sewer & Water Department through the Clerk's Office, under provisions of Section 21, Act 94 of Public Acts of Michigan, 1933 as amended, to any premises thereon delinquent past the third quarter or more by October 31st of that year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Cottrellville, County of St. Clair, State of Michigan, that effective immediately, that all unpaid water & sewer bills that are outstanding as of October 31st, or if a "Payment Plan Agreement" is entered into, however never executed to completion of payments in a timely fashion, the outstanding balance as of that date shall be entered onto property tax roll for the winter tax bill of that year, by the Township Assessor, to the premises to which such services have been rendered, and said charges shall be collected and said lien shall be enforced in the same manner as provided in respect to taxes assessed upon the roll. On any rental properties, the Township Board shall require a cash deposit in the amount determined by the Clerk's Office and held as a line item of the records collected by the Treasurer's Office until such time all balances are paid in full, and the deposit shall be returned to the person named on the receipt supplied by our Treasurer and Clerk upon vacating the premises, once all water & sewer invoices are satisfied & paid for that address.


