THIS RESOLUTION TO REVISE RESOLUTION # R-2012-03, ADOPTED APRIL 11TH, 2012 REFERRED TO AS A **RESOLUTION FOR A CHANGE IN WATER BILLING DUE DATE FOR COLLECTION OF PAYMENTS**; & SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE, WITH A FORMATTED SCHEDULE OF THE FOLLOWING:

WHEREAS, at the time the Resolution # R-2012-03 was adopted, the water bills were being read at different times and not produced into invoices and mailed in a fashion that a due date of the 25th day following the quarter being billed was offering enough time for customers to pay their invoices.

WHEREAS, at the request of the Township Clerk, once the meter readings are completed, and the invoices prepared for mailing, the water billing invoice shall be paid within 30 days from the date on invoice so that residents can receive additional time to meet their financial obligation. This shall remain the same as originally prepared as adopted on April 11th, 2012 by Resolution # R-2012-03. Any payment plans must be applied for and approved prior to the due date of invoice.

WHEREAS, Michigan statute authorizes the Township Board to make these policy changes in the form of a Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Township of Cottrellville does hereby resolve to allow the following:

"Shut-Off Notices" for non-payment of the water bills will be mailed out the day after the due date stated on the invoice and a 10% penalty shall be added to this delinquent water bill. If the invoice is not paid in full by the shut-off due date, then the water shall be shut off the next day.


An additional \$40 to shut off the customer will be added to the invoice, and prior to turning the customer back on, another \$40 shall be added to be turned back on. The past due invoice, with the 10% penalty and the Turn On and Turn Off fees, will need to be paid in full prior to being turned back on to our system.

This schedule shall apply to the first, second & fourth quarters of each calendar year. The third quarter of each year, the meters shall be read, processed and mailed, however, the water bill must be paid by the last business day of October. No Shut-Off notices shall be sent out in the third quarter, however, any all amounts due and owing by the last business day of October, shall roll-over to property taxes on the December Winter Tax bill for that year. If the customer is a renter, the landlord/property owner shall receive a copy of this invoice and they shall be made aware that the past due water invoice shall become a lien on their property.
